The Lead Slinging Classic (LSC) is a fundraiser for the Adaptive Sports and Adventures Program (ASAP) of Carolinas HealthCare System. ASAP is a community-based organization that is proudly housed by Carolinas Rehabilitation Hospital in Charlotte, North Carolina. By extending the rehabilitation process beyond therapy, ASAP helps individuals integrate into ongoing community activities and programs. Some of the benefits of the programs provided by ASAP include: decreased social isolation, decreased stress and pain associated with disability, and an increased awareness in abilities.

ASAP relies on philanthropic donations to provide a variety of programs for over 200 individuals of all ages with disabilities in our community. Programs include water and snow skiing, cycling, rugby, curling, tennis, hunting, and swimming to name a few. These experiences become a turning point in people's lives, where confidence is bred and self-esteem soars.

It is the mission of the LSC to help raise funds for these programs and to promote awareness of physical disabilities to our region through a 5-Stand Skeet Shoot Competition. The LSC began in 2013 as a result of the overwhelming interest and support that was seen as shooters in wheelchairs lined up to participate in skeet and 5-stand competitions when a local shooting club, the Mecklenburg BullShooters, provided the traps and set the target presentations as an opportunity to reach more shooters with disabilities. Today, the number of shooters who participate in the LSC has increased to over 75.

This year's LSC will consist of a 5-Stand Competition, a Beginner Stand with a NSCA Level II shooting instructor, and Silent Auction that is hosted by Kasey Westmoreland, a quadriplegic since age 16, at Westmoreland Farm in Huntersville, North Carolina. The event will take place from 9:00a.m. to 5:00p.m. on May 4, 2019.

The number of individuals that ASAP serves continues to grow. We need your help expanding and maintaining these vital community programs.
